FINAL ORDER

Graylen Ellis, Jr. has filed a petition for expungement of police records and court records, pursuant to §19.2-392.2, *Code of Virginia*. The Petitioner has obtained from the Prince William County Police Department one complete set of his fingerprints. The Police Department has filed with the Court a copy of Mr. Ellis' criminal history, a copy of the source documents that resulted in the CCRE entry that he wishes to expunge, and the set of fingerprints. A hearing has been conducted on that petition.

The Court makes the following findings of fact:

1. The full name of the petitioner used at the time of his arrest is Graylen Ellis, Jr.
2. The petitioner's date of birth is August 8, 1981.
3. The specific criminal charges to be expunged are "Abduction by Force," "Use of Firearm in Commission of Felony," "Pointing/Brandishing

Firearm" and "Assault on a Family Member."

4. The petitioner was arrested on October 16, 2013, by the Prince William County Police Department.

5. The date of final disposition of these charges as set forth in this petition was on January 10, 2014. The charges were dismissed by order of *nolle prosequi*.

6. The Petitioner has no prior criminal record and no good cause can be shown as to why he should not be entitled to expungement of the police and court records relating to these charges.

7. The continued existence and possible dissemination of information relating to the arrest of the Petitioner causes or may cause circumstances which constitute a manifest injustice to him.

**ORDERED** that the Petition for Expungement is granted.

**ORDERED** that the fingerprint card be returned to the Petitioner.

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court forward a copy of this Order to the Department of State Police.

**ORDERED** that the Department of State Police shall, in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to §9.1-134, *Code of Virginia*, direct the






manner by which the appropriate expungement or removal of such records shall be effected.


