

As in any given year, Stafford County faces challenges and opportunities. The Board of Supervisors has worked together in addressing the challenges of maintaining a Triple A Bond Rating and low taxes while continuing to experience growth, and address community needs. With the sound leadership we have today, Stafford also has the opportunity to continue managing growth and foster even greater economic development and job growth. Yet these issues continue to confront us.

As a result of the recent vacancy by Mr. Robert Thomas, I hope to meet the exciting opportunity, and the personal challenge, to continue to work with the Stafford Board of Supervisors in aiding our county. Serving as the appointee to the Board would certainly be a step up from my role as Chairman of the Stafford Planning Commission, but I believe my service on the Commission these past four years, as well as my previous service on numerous other local boards and commissions over the past nearly two decades have demonstrated my interest in the county and commitment to its future.

During my years in Stafford I have undertaken to improve the quality of life and to plan for the county's future. My experience is diverse, from community to political, and importantly, governmental. For over four years I have served on the Planning Commission, in leadership positions for three of them. This work afforded me knowledge of the Comprehensive Growth Plan, traffic patterns and issues, the old and new proffer laws and cluster developments, among other issues. As Chair of the Comp Plan Sub-committee I led the process which developed to the update which was passed by both the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors with few alterations or conflicts. My work on the SCPS Capital Improvements Plan Citizens Advisory Committee furnished me knowledge of processes, policies and methods of how the school system develops its CIP as well as the county's process. Part of my teaching of government on both the high school and college level includes the budget process, the theories and realities. As the Coordinator of Student Government Day for the past seventeen years I have had the pleasure of working with staff from all the government departments.

Throughout my service it has been an honor to have repeatedly been elected to leadership positions. On every county body, members have placed me in key leadership positions, including chair of each at least once. In the workplace co-workers for over a decade elected me as Department Chair and I was selected to attend a Leadership Fellowship at the University of Mary Washington. The College Board has selected me to serve in leadership positions for over a decade. Members of these organizations, boards and departments have cited professionalism, openness, fairness and the ability to bring people together as traits that aid me in leading the groups to successful results. Being a team player and not seeking individual attention, but recognizing that decisions are made by consensus are also mentioned. Whether on committees

that deal with issues as volatile as redistricting or the Comprehensive Plan or less contentious issues, it is important to recognize that end products must be viable and able to be adopted. It is important that fellow members feel that their work and opinions have been valued and productive. Additionally, key to all activities are listening and respecting others. Members come to the table with knowledge and experience as well as ideas. It is important to create an environment where they feel that they will be listened to and have a positive impact.

This appointment will afford me the opportunity to continue my work for Stafford. In the near term there are several issues which the county must address; the budget, growth, including upcoming housing developments, the CIP and addressing issues in projections and enrollments as well as their fiscal impact. As my resume illustrates, these are all areas in which I have been involved and allows me to be able to assist the Board in its deliberations. These issues tie into long term goals: managing and directing growth, establishing procedures for long term planning both financial as well as infrastructure, shifting away from playing "catch up or keep up", economic development and importantly, preserving the county's rural character which is important, especially to the George Washington District.

Over the years it has been my pleasure to work with members of the board on different projects and levels. My hope is that you will allow me to bring my knowledge and experience to the board, where we can work together for Stafford's future.
