**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fredericksburg Nationals look to avoid a series sweep against the Delmarva Shorebirds, Low-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, on Sunday afternoon...it's the final game of a six-game set and sixth in a 12-game homestand.

**ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT:** The FredNats lost their 11th straight game on Saturday night, falling 13-2 to the Shorebirds...Delmarva exploded for a nine-run third inning, collecting only three hits but taking advantage of three walks, two hit batsmen and four errors...Leif Strom took the loss, allowing nine runs, three earned in 2.1 innings...the Fredericksburg offense managed only one hit, a Jeremy Ydens single off the left field wall in the fourth...Bryan Peña pitched well in relief for the FredNats, allowing only one run on three hits in 4.0 innings.

**AND THEN THERE WERE TWO:** There are two teams remaining in Minor League Baseball still looking for their first win...the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers of the Low-A East's Central Division started 0-10, but defeated the Fayetteville Woodpeckers 1-0 on Saturday night...the Binghamtom Rumble Ponies of the Double-A Northeast are 0-10, and lost 6-5 in ten innings to the Altoona Curve on Saturday.

**A LITTLE PERSPECTIVE:** In 2008, the Triple-A Lehigh Valley IronPigs began the history of their franchise with an 0-11 start....they finally beat Richmond 3-1 in their 12th game...they stayed in a funk, starting the season 4-28, before finishing the year 55-89.

CALLING IN THE CAVALRY: The FredNats received three new players from the Complex League in Florida in time for Friday's game...outfielder Jeremy De La Rosa, infielder Viandel Peña and infielder Leandro Emiliani were all added to the roster...infielder Gio Díaz and outfielder Zach Cornell were transferred to the Complex League...De La Rosa, 19, was signed out of the Dominican Republic in 2018 and is currently ranked the #6 prospect in the Nationals organization according to MLB Pipeline...Peña is currently ranked #28...Emiliani and Peña debuted in Friday's game, and De La Rosa debuted on Saturday...all three are looking for their first hit.

**IN NEED OF RELIEF:** The FredNats' 8.32 ERA is highest in the Low-A East, with the Low-A Southeast's Dunedin Blue Jays (8.81) the only team in Minor League Baseball with a higher mark...the team ERA has gone down over the past three games...the 29 unearned runs allowed is the most in the minors.

**FLASHING THE BAT SIGNAL:** The FredNats' team batting average of .162 is lowest in the Low-A East...the only team in minor league baseball with a lower team batting average is the Nats' Double-A Harrisburg Senators at .146.

**SYSTEM UPDATE:** The FredNats aren't the only Washington affiliate to get off to a slow start in the first week of the minor league season... Triple-A Rochester are 2-9 and Double-A Harrisburg is 3-8...Harrisburg fell victim to a combined no-hitter on Thursday night against the Richmond Flying Squirrels...Advanced-A Wilmington has overcome a slow start and is now 5-6, losing on Saturday to snap a five-game winning streak.

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER: Tuesday's home opener will be remembered in Fredericksburg for years to come...FredNats Ballpark welcomed a sellout crowd of 2065 fans to the ballpark for the first game in the ballpark's history...in a pregame ceremony, first pitches were thrown by team owner Art Silber and Fredericksburg mayor Mary Katherine Greenlaw...the FredNats jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first, with Geraldi Diaz collecting the ballpark's first hit and Jake Randa hitting the first home run...Delmarva took the lead for good in the seventh on a three-run homer from Gunnar Henderson and eventually won 7-5.

**BIRD IS THE WORD:** Today marks the sixth of 36 matchups between the FredNats and Shorebirds...after this series, the two teams will meet next in Fredericksburg from June 1-6...the first series to take place at Delmarva will be June 22-27...due to the unbalanced schedule, 96 of Fredericksburg's 120 games will be within the four-team Northern Division of the Low-A East (Lynchburg, Delmarva, Salem).

**MARIO'S SUPER SLUGGERS:** The FredNats are helmed by Mario Lissón in his third season as a manager in the organization, and first in Fredericksburg...he managed the GCL Nationals in 2018 and 2019, leading his teams to a 49-56 overall record over two seasons...he played 12 years in affiliated professional baseball, reaching as high as Triple-A between the Royals, Giants and Nationals organizations.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Karlo Seijas makes his third FredNats start in the series finale against Delmarva.

LAST TIME OUT: Seijas pitched the inaugural game at FredNats Ballpark last Tuesday, receiving a no-decision in a game the FredNats lost 7-5...Seijas went 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on one hit while striking out six...he struck out Mason Janvrin in the first inning for the first strikeout in the ballpark's history...he didn't allow a hit until Gunnar Henderson's one-out single in the fourth, and after walking two batters he left with the bases loaded and two outs leading 3-0...Bryan Peña allowed a two-run single to Dylan Harris, bringing home two inherited runners...Delmarva scored 4 in the seventh on homers from Henderson and JD Mundy to win the game.

**PRE-PANDEMIC:** Seijas held a 5-8 career record with a 4.45 ERA in 87.0 innings entering the 2021 season...he made his professional debut in 2018 for the DSL Nationals in 2018, starting 12 games and going 2-7 with a 5.47 ERA in 54.1 innings...in 2019 he spent most of the season with the GCL Nationals, going 3-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 32.2 innings...he appeared in 10 games, two of them starts...he pitched in one game for SS-Auburn, allowing 3 runs, 2 earned, in 4.0 innings to earn a save for the Doubledays.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Full name: Karlo Domingo Seijas...at age 20, second-youngest player on the FredNats Opening Day roster (Michael Cuevas, 19)...warm-up music is Lo Logre by Jose Reyes, featuring Jay the Prince...on Instagram @Karloseijas47... favorite movie is Rocky Balboa...favorite television show is Tom and Jerry...favorite players growing up were fellow Venezuelans Miguel Cabrera and Félix Hernández... played Call of Duty: Warzone during the pandemic...pregame meal is gomas de mascar (chewing gum)...secret talent is playing MLB The Show 21...he likes visiting Washington, D.C.

**AGAINST THE SHOREBIRDS:** Seijas had never faced the Shorebirds before, or an Orioles affiliate at any level, before starting the series opener on Tuesday.

**DOING THE SPLITS:** In his career entering 2021, Seijas has remarkably even left/right splits...lefties are batting .248 against him, while righties are batting .238... however, righties have done more damage with the long ball, hitting all six home runs that Seijas surrendered in 2018 and 2019...opponents were batting just .029 (1-for-35) against him when Seijas was ahead in the count.

**THEY SAID IT:** In his preseason media availability, Nationals assistant general manager Mark Scialabba said of Seijas: "Strike thrower, young, aggressive, just starting to blossom into some velocity...secondary pitches with some upside."
